

Light

A Concordance Study of the Word *LIGHT*

Hebrew - ore Greek - phos, foce - Luminous, break of day, glorious, light set on fire, lightning in every sense, happiness, morning sun, shine, manifest

Shekinah, Heb. - skn - shaken - Greek skeen (o) - a tent, divinity and humanity dwelling together, presence of divinity, pitched (Matt. 1:23; John 6:68) - parallels glory and name
glory Heb. kabod; Greek doxa (doxazo) - many of the same definitions in light, glory and name

Gen. 1:3,4 God said, "Let there be light, and there was light" - Light was good - light separated from darkness

Ex. 13:21 pillar of fire to give light by night

Ex. 14:20 pillar of cloud - separate Israel from Egypt

Ps. 44:3 The light of God's presence - Heb. - ore

Ps. 56:13 Walk before God in the light of the living (Job 33:30) - Soul is enlightened with the light of life.

Isa. 2:5 Come, house of Jacob - let us walk in the light of the Lord.

Isa. 5:20, 30 Woe - if you substitute light for darkness and darkness for light

Isa. 8: 20 To law and testimony - they do not speak according to this word, because they have no dawn (light).

Isa. 9:2 Darkness will see a great light - Those in darkness will have a great light shine upon them.

Isa. 50:10, 11 Walking in darkness has no light - there is torment for those who ignore the light.

Isa. 58: 8, 10; 59: 9; 60: 1, 3 Light brings righteousness - light displaced darkness - we hope for light - shine your light - brightness.

Matt 5:14, 15, 16 Gr phos - (manifest, brilliance, radiance) You are the light of the world - let your light shine - it will glorify Father in heaven.

Matt 6: 22, 23 Eye is lamp, if clear, then will whole body be full of light
- if eye is bad, the light in you is darkness
- can only serve one master - love or hate

John 1: 4 - 8 John 1:1 puts Jesus before Gen 1:1 (Christ was) [was made - Gr. ginomai, a form of the word name] (Ps. 90:2) see ginomai - emi - was God before life is light (Isa. 9:1, 2) - divine presence - illumines hearts and minds with light of divine love (2 Cor 4: 6). (Ps. 36:9) Christ is source of light (false light - Isa. 50:11; James 1:17) - light bearer - Gr. luchnos - Christ's people -

Truth is light (Mal. 4:2; 2 Peter 1:19) Phil. 2:6 - 8 Christ is God. Col. 2:9 fullness of Godhead. Matt 1:23; John 6:68 dwelt, tented, pitched Gr skenos.

John 3:19 - 21 Judgment Gr. krisis - light rejected for the love of darkness - light creates judgment (Jn 15:22) (2 Cor. 4:4) evildoers hate light - practicing truth brings light that manifests source to God Jn 8:12; 10:28. (Glory Gr doxa, doxazo; Heb. kabod) radiance of light.

John 5:35 John the Baptist was a lamp Gr. luchnos - a burning light Gr. kaio - set on fire by greater light.

John 8:12 The True Light (Jesus) supplanted. The Feast of Tabernacles and the ceremony of lights - That light which is life - the source of all life (1 Jn 5:12)

John 9:5 Jesus IS the Light of the World.

John 11:9, 10 Walking in daylight is sure, in darkness will stumble - walk with light in your self-light of Christ.

John 12:35, 36, 46 Walk with the Light whole. He is with you - do not let darkness overtake you - believe on the light to become a son of the light - I am the Light, follow me out of the darkness.

Acts 4:12 There is salvation in no one else; for there is no other NAME under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

Acts 9:3 A light flashed around him (Christ around Paul)

Acts 13:47 You are a light unto the Gentiles that you may bring salvation to the end of the earth (Isa. 42:6; 49:6)

Acts 16:29 Prison guard called for lights to find salvation in the darkness vs. 30, 31, believe in Jesus and be saved.

Acts 22:6, 9, 11 Bright light flashed from heaven all around - all saw the light but did not understand - blinded by the light, Paul was led by the hand.

Acts 26:13, 18, 23 Light from heaven to open their eyes - to turn from darkness - from Satan to God to receive forgiveness and an inheritance by faith - Christ proclaimed light by His death and resurrection.

Romans 2:19; 13:12 Instruction of the letter of the law makes you a blind guide, a light of darkness - wear the armor of light.

Eph 5:8, 13, 14 You are the light in the Lord - light exposes darkness - Christ will shine on / in you.

Col 1:12 The Father qualifies His people to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light.

1 Thes 5:4, 5 You brethren, are not in the darkness - for you are sons of light.

1 Tim 6:16 The only Sovereign, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light.

2 Tim 1:10 Our Savior, Jesus Christ who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellences of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light
(Isa 43:20; 61:6; Ex 19:5, 6; Isa 9:2; 42:16)

2 Peter 1:19 A sure word as a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your heart
(1 Pet 1:10; Heb 2:2; Ps 119:105; Luke 1:78; Rev 22:16; 2 Cor 4:6)

1 John 1:5, 7; 2:8 - 10 God is Light - but only if we walk in the Light - and the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin. Jesus, the True Light, is shining - love abides in the Light - hate blinds and walks in the darkness - love one another.

Rev 16:8 The light scorched men with fire - literal and spiritual (see literal in Rev 20, 21, 22)

Rev 18:23 The light of a lamp will not shine in you any longer because all the nations were deceived by your sorcery.

Rev 21:11, 23, 24 Holy city having the glory of God and brilliance - the glory of God has illuminated it and its lamp is the lamb - nations will walk by its light.

Rev 22:5 No need for light - for the Lord God will illuminate them.
